




The Season of

Good News – You could have a 2014 tax credit!

The AAPC is a non-profit 501(c)(3) (FEIN 30-0081868) organization, certified as a Qualifying Charitable Organization by the Arizona Department of Revenue, so when it comes time to file your 2014 tax returns, you may be able to use your donation or sponsorship for a state tax credit of up to \$200 for a single person and \$400 for a married couple. You may also take the federal tax deduction. Check with your tax adviser. Eligible donations for 2014 may be made until December 31, 2014.
